1. Summary

- Since 2010, LLT have completed delivery of 16 courses and qualified 164 specialist EfS instructors. QMU had previously qualified an additional 32 EfS instructors.
- So total of 196 EfS instructors across UK now.

2. Development Work

LLT's main aim was to maintain the quality of the course but make it viable in cost both to future candidates and to LLT. LLT have trained up 2 specialist exercise instructors (who work with Stroke patients) from the LLT tutor team, as well as the training up of 2 specialist Stroke physiotherapists to ensure standardised and quality assured delivery has been our priority. LLT have also trained up two other specialist tutors to assess the practical elements, both formative and summative.

3. Accreditation and Endorsement


 The course has undergone the accreditation process to secure 20 credit points for successful completion from Queen Margaret's University, Edinburgh. This accreditation allows the potential for prior learning credits (20 credits at SCQF Level 8) after successful completion of the EfS course at other University's towards a degree.

- The EfS Course is accredited by Skills Active and the Register of Exercise Professionals (REPS) at Level 4 and receives 20 CPD points.
- The course is endorsed by the UK Forum for Stroke Training, with a specific unique Quality Mark number QM0045.

4. Courses Completed

Sixteen courses have been completed, with a total of 221 candidates from three main professional backgrounds.

12 in England, 2 in Wales, 2 in Scotland (previous 3 QMU courses were all in Scotland).

6. Pass Rates


The assessments include a Theory Paper, a Case Study and a Practical Assessment of their delivery and tailoring of the exercises.

A total of 221 candidates applied to the above 16 Courses of which 164 have received Qualification Certificates (*74% first time pass rate*). 33 candidates have received Attendance Certificates (15%), 6 candidates dropped out (3%) and the remaining 18 candidates (8%) will resit some elements of the assessment.

6. Qualified EfS Specialist Instructor Professions

The professions of candidates who have qualified are as follows:-

- Exercise Instructors 70.7%
- Physiotherapists 11.0%
- Exercise Physiologists 6.7%
- Physio Assistants 3.0%
- Nurses 1.8%
- Exercise Referral Officers 1.8%
- Others 3.0%
- Unknown 2.4%

6. On Site Courses
